Incident: Stalking by an unknown male.

Detail of Event:

On 09-28-2017 at 0900, a female, age 28 years, reported to Deputy Steven Jameson about noticing an individual following her home every day. A female named Lena Anderson noticed this started happening around 08-29-2017. At first, she thought it was just a coincidence when they would end up outside her apartment. Then she saw it became more frequent. The suspicious individual would follow her from wherever she was and would get on the same train or bus as her and get off at the same stop. The individual would then follow her to her apartment and would stand outside her window and stare. Lena lives in a third-floor apartment and feels uncomfortable experiencing this.

Actions Taken:

Deputy Jameson suggested Lena try and change her schedule. Another suggestion was that she could get a clear picture of the suspect to notify the police. If Lena feels too uncomfortable, she was told to come to the police station again, and they could help make sure she makes it home and stop the suspicious individual.

Summary:

Lena Anderson is 28, female, and being stalked by an unknown suspect. Should anything else happen, she is to notify the police. If the suspect becomes violent or tries to make contact, inform the police immediately. Until then, documentation has been written up and a case file created. Police are to follow up in two weeks.

Officer Jameson: Field Notes

- Residence entered Nov 16, 0500 a.m. Front door ajar. No signs of forced entry.
- Laptop active, displaying open Drafts folder.
- Journal found open to last written entry dated Nov 15, 2017.
- Curtains drawn tight with safety pins and duct tape.
- Cell phone found under the couch, screen cracked, last unlocked at 13:55.
- No trace of the victim. The mug on the table is still warm.

Interviewed neighbors:

- **Mrs. Benjamin (apartment 3B)** reports “a man in a dark hood” loitering near the stairwell at she thinks 10pm. the previous night. Described him as “tall, wrong-looking somehow—like he didn’t fit the light.”
- Reports of weird noises heard from the apartment by those underneath and on the same floor.
- Surveillance camera outside the building records static from 2000–2100

Daily Journal

Date: 11-15-2017

I know who it is now that's been following me. It's Liam, it has to be! He faked his death, I know it! The obituary is a lie, it was a closed casket funeral, they just wanted us to think he's been dead! I have a plan though. Tonight I'm going to wait for him to come in the house and then I'll tackle him to the ground after hitting. Once I have him down I'll tie him up and call the police, prove it's been Liam this whole time. No one will dare call me a liar again! Though if anything happens to me just know it's Liam, it has to be. I can't afford to be wrong.

The date is Nov. 15, 2017 and the time is 8am, if anything happens, tell my parents I love them.
